RESOLUTION NO. 07-04

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2007-2035 JCCOG LONG-RANGE MULTI-MODAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation through the provisions of federal transportation legislation requires all metropolitan planning organizations to have an adopted long-range multi-modal transportation plan for the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, said plan is to be updated every five years; and

WHEREAS, JCCOG has updated its long-range multi-modal transportation plan and has added demographic, environmental, arterial street modeling, and other pertinent information and visualization techniques to improve local transportation planning decision making; and


WHEREAS, the 2007-2035 JCCOG Long-Range Multi-Modal Transportation Plan has been subjected to the JCCOG public participation process, and all public comments received have been forwarded to the JCCOG Transportation Technical Advisory Committee and JCCOG Urbanized Area Policy Board for consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE URBANIZED AREA POLICY BOARD OF THE JOHNSON COUNTY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, THAT:

1. The 2007-2035 JCCOG Long-Range Multi-Modal Transportation Plan is adopted.
2. The 2007-2035 JCCOG Long-Range Multi-Modal Transportation Plan shall be used by JCCOG member communities as a guide for transportation planning and programming decisions.

It was moved by Correia and seconded by Herwig the Resolution be adopted. The motion passed on a vote of 13 affirmative, 0 negative, and 0 abstaining.
